MAKE SURE TO APPLY FOR OR HAVE A PASSPORT

Your first passport?

If you have never had a U.S. passport and plan to travel in November, it is recommended to apply for a passport at least 4-6 months in advance.

Applying in ensures sufficient time to receive your passport well before our planned departure in November.

Note: The U.S. Department of State's website indicates much shorter processing times than our recommendation.

Expedited and urgent processing times are available for an additional fee, if needed.


